Community Foundation Scholarships

The Shenango Valley Community Foundation Scholarship Website is now LIVE. Students have from January 1st – March 1st to complete all Community Foundation Scholarships online. Seniors must go online to www.comm-foundation.org to apply for scholarships.

1. WKBN 27 CARING FOR OUR COMMUNITY TOM HOLDEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The intent is to award one junior or senior high school student a \$1,500 college scholarship. Students have to write a 30 second PSA (Public Service Announcement) for a local non-profit organization from the list provided. Applications are available in the guidance office, on the Class of 2022 Google Classroom or on-line at www.WKBN.com.

The deadline for entries is February 18, 2022.

2. BUHL REGIONAL HEALTH FOUNDATION'S HEALTH CAREER SCHOLARSHIPS

The BRHF Scholarship Application Portal is now open. Students must live in the Buhl Regional Health Foundation's service area. Be pursuing a bachelor's degree or higher in a health-related field. Have a GPA of 3.5 or above. Be enrolled as a full-time college student for the 2022-2023 academic year at an accredited college or university.

All applications must be received by 11:59 p.m. on February 15, 2022.

3. ALPHA KAPPA ALPHA SOROITY, INC. SCHOLARSHIP

AKA will award two scholarships to deserving minority high school students who will graduate from a Trumbull/Mahoning County or Mercer County high school this year and attend an accredited college or university in the Fall.

Completed applications must be submitted by March 15, 2022.

7. THE NORTHWESTERN PENNSYLVANIA AREA LABOR FEDERATION, AFL-CIO SCHOLARSHIPS

This program sponsors scholarships for graduating seniors. Applications are available in the guidance office and on the Class of 2022 Google Classroom. *Completed applications must be submitted by February 28, 2022.*

8. PENNSYLVANIA HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES SCHOLARSHIP

This program provides four-year scholarships to two high school seniors. Applications are available in the guidance office and on the Class of 2022 Google Classroom. *Completed applications must be submitted by March 1, 2022.*

9. SARA A. WINLAND ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP, P.E.O. CHAPTER BG

P.E.O. is a philanthropic organization where women celebrate the advancement of women: education women through scholarships, grants, awards, loans, and stewardship of Cottey College; and motivate women to achieve their highest aspirations. 10. THE GEORGE W. WRIGHT STUDENTS AID FUND
